









Tic-Tac-Toe

(Person, Place, Thing, or Idea)

Materials: Dice, pencils and small counters (one color per player)

Object of the game: To be the first player to create a line of 3 boxes on any of the three game boards (vertically, horizontally, or diagonally).

Directions: On your turn, roll the dice. Look at the chart below to find which type of noun you may cover for that roll. You may cover an example of that type of noun with ONE of your counters on any of the three game boards below. If there are no available boxes, your turn is over. The first player to cover a line of 3 boxes on any game board with his/her own counters is the winner.
